What is the Fast Vigil?

As congress members return to Washington D.C. in early September to close out the session, students and supporters will be fasting to stress *urgency and accountability* around the student legalization legislations.

What is the DREAM Act and the Student Adjustment Act?

The DREAM Act and the Student Adjustment are *bi-partisan legislations* currently pending in Congress which would give undocumented immigrant students a chance to pursue *higher education* and obtain *legal status*.

Who is organizing this action?

This action is organized by the *Los Angeles DREAM Team*, a coalition of immigrant rights organizations, student groups, faith based groups, labor unions, and policy groups. This action is nationally coordinated by the *United We DREAM Campaign* and the *New American Opportunity Campaign*.
