Rabbi Mark Diamond and Bishop Jon Bruno, along with many other interfaith clergy and laity, are leading a committee to call attention to the current situation in Darfur, in the Western Sudan, which has been called the worst humanitarian crisis in the world. More than fifty thousand have been killed since the conflict erupted in February of 2003, and 1.4 million people have been driven from their homes.

This event will begin with a candlelight vigil outside the Islamic Center of Southern California, where participants will listen to the Muslim call to prayer, and then begin a march. At the entrance to Immanuel Presbyterian Church, music and prayers will greet the participants as they move on to the Wilshire Boulevard Temple to listen to the blast of the shofar. The march will conclude at St. Basil's Roman Catholic Church, where the Lost Boys of the Sudan Choir will sing, and representatives from all of the Abrahamic traditions will conduct an interfaith service, and charge us with a call to action.
